## CLASSES

**CLASS 1 RESTRICTED NOVICE** - For horses that have not been placed in the first three more than once in any One Day Event, Hunter Trials or Cross Country Competition and that have not competed any BE Horse Trials at Pre-Novice level or above.

Dressage Test: Intro Dressage Test 102 (2001)  
Showjumping: 80 cm  
Cross Country: Approx 80 cm

**CLASS 2 NOVICE** - Open to horses that are not eligible for Class 1 and that have not been placed in the first 6 in any BE Pre-Novice event or above.

Dressage Test: Intro Dressage Test 102 (2001)  
Showjumping: 90 cm  
Cross Country: Approx 90 cm

**CLASS 3 OPEN** - Open to all.

Dressage Test: Pre-Novice Dressage Test 111 (2001)  
Showjumping: 1.00 m  
Cross Country: Approx 1.00 m

This class will be run over the Aldon BE pre-novice fences.

**Rosettes will be given to 8th place and prizes to 3rd place.  
The Sandby Puffin Trophy and The Aldon Cup will be given to  
the highest placed SWDG Member in the Open Sections.**

*Please note that we may run Class 2 first, before Class 1*

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE **12 YEARS OR OVER**
2. Entries will be limited and accepted on a first come, first served basis. We will run a waiting list and in previous years, all those on the list were able to compete.
3. The competition will be run under the BHS Riding Club Rules for Horse Trials except that: **a) neither the cross country nor the show jumping will be timed** and **b) in the case of equality of faults after cross country and show jumping scores have been taken into consideration, the Collective Marks in the dressage phase will be the deciding factor.**
4. Horses may be downgraded in accordance with Riding Club Rules.
5. All dogs must be kept on leads.
6. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are responsible, neither the organisers nor the BHS, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.  
We recommend you take out Personal Accident Insurance.
